Terms and conditions:

1. All trees –adopted or not- are part of the orchard, and this means they will be looked after in exactly the same manner as all other trees in the orchard. We will take the very best care of your apple tree, throughout the whole year.
2. We will let you know by e-mail when your harvest date will be. The dates will be in a weekend. If you can not come on the suggested dates, you will have a few options:
 - You could come on a weekend. To be confirmed by email.
 - You could ask us to harvest the apples for you. This would cost £5.-/tree and you can come and pick up the apples in the next week.
3. We could send the apples to you, for an additional £12.50.

Please note that we will take very good care when packing your apples, but because they are seen as perishable goods by the delivery services, we can not insure the apples. This is normally no problem, but we can not guarantee the apples will reach you in perfect condition.

4. We can store the apples for you in our cold store, for £1, - /box (14kg) per week.
5. Communication with you will be done by e-mail. We would appreciate it if you would do the same.
6. On your adoption certificate you will find a description of the tree. You must bring the certificate on harvest days as proof of adoption and to help our staff direct you to your tree(s).

We have a young orchard, which is still coming in production. This means that for example a 4 years old tree will give more apples than a 2 years old tree. This is reflected in the price of adopting a tree.

About us:

We are Stein Leenders and Noor Bunnik. We started growing at our site at Tablehurst Orchard, Tablehurst Farm. We came here with our trees in 2001. At Tablehurst Orchard we grow 5.5 ha of Jonagold apples, and 1ha of Elstar apples. You may have seen the Jonagold apples in local stores, as well as in Sainsbury's supermarket. They are quite easy to recognise, because they tend to be very big and shiny dark-red and sweet.

You will be adopting an apple tree at the new Brambletye fruit farm, near the Brambletye ruins, Forest Row. At this site there are 4ha of Evita apples. They are crispy, fresh tasting apples, which can be stored quite well. Further there are 3ha of summer apples, called Collina, and 3ha of Concorde pears, as well as some rows of different, special varieties, also available for adoption.

In addition to that we grow red currents, blackberries, gooseberries, blueberries, and a small patch of raspberries in partnership with Auke Zirkzee. We also share the land with 1500 laying hens, managed by Daniel Hoeberichts and Karen Perenboom.

We have so many orchards to manage now, that we got ourselves an orchard manager, who helps to organise all the work. His name is Axel Schallies. Remember that name, because on harvest days he is sure to be around, to help you to get started.

Four year old trees, adoption price £38,-

- Topaz** appletree, the harvest will usually be in the last weekend of September. These store well, and taste nice and fresh.
- Golden Delicious apple**, the harvest will be in October. This is a yellow crunchy, juicy and fresh tasting apple.

Three year old trees, adoption price £22,-

- Collina apple**, this is a lovely sweet and juicy summer apple, ready for harvest the second or third week of August. (Is prone to dropping off the tree when ripe)

Two years old trees, adoption price £13.50

- Sirius apple**
- Opal apple**
- Luna apple**
- Gieser Wildeman Pear**, a cooking pear, ready for harvest end of October.

Smaller two years old trees, adoption price £8.75

- Red Lane apple**, this is an apple which is purple-red on the outside and also red on the inside. It's a very aromatic tasting apple and the harvest will be in the beginning of September.
- Moonlight apple**, these are green-yellow apples, that taste very good and are lovely and juicy. They will be harvested in the second half of September.
