

CAPITAL DECISION-MAKING TOOL

Any new project or idea is going to take resources. This is a way of assessing the resources you need to help you decide whether to proceed or not. If you have the resources you need, great, go ahead! If you don't have the resources you need, can you get them? If not, how important are they? Can you go ahead without those resources? Does it increase your risk if you do go ahead without those resources?

If you do proceed, then this is also a very useful start in managing your project as you've already identified many of the resources you need.

Cultural	<i>e.g. historical legacy, values, beliefs, traditions</i>
