

## Certification fees for Aquaculture to Soil Association standards or organic regulations (in GB or NI)



### Application review fee

The application review fee is applied to all aquaculture applications. This will cover a full review of your application documentation, including the site description and sustainability management plan, environmental impact assessments (where required) and the animal health management plan (where required). This review will ensure that we have assessed that organic certification is appropriate for your operation. Following a successful application review, the annual fee will be charged, and the application can progress to the application inspection stage.

We estimate that this application review will take 6 weeks to complete, this is based on submission of all the required information, this timeframe may vary depending on the scope of the application.

Where a new site is added to an existing licence, the application review fee will be applicable. Following successful review, the additional inspection charges will be applied to cover a site inspection.
